



## Data Research Internship with REN21

### Responsibilities

- Research and analyse new data in collaboration with the network's partners, e.g. network of regional contributors, IEA, World Bank, ministries, industry associations, NGOs, independent experts etc
- Organise data from existing REN21 reports and activities (Global Status Report, Global Futures Report)
- Collect and compile energy statistics and data in a meaningful way
- Translate data into indicators and trends
- Check data for completeness and consistency
- Assist in the preparation of methodology for data collection and processing
- Support the day-to-day operation of the REN21 Secretariat

### Requirements

- Studies in economics, statistics or any social science with a major focus on renewable energy / environmental studies, or similar
- Strong numerical and IT skills
- Excellent written and oral English skills and good command of written and oral; other languages are a valuable asset
- Good understanding of renewable energy policy and development cooperation
- Enjoy networking and team work
- Attention to detail and clean presentation
- Ability to prioritize, multi-task and deliver in regards to deadlines
